Addressing Individual Differences

- If you have seen/known one person with FASD... Well, you have seen/known precisely one person with FASD
- Across the board policies with no exceptions are legally suspect...
- A diagnosis is the key to opening many doors; evaluations with recommendations are even better. Neuropsych?

Legal Protections

- There are a number of applicable legal protections which are often needed:
 - IDEA (especially Transition Services, Discipline)
 - Section 504
 - ADA
 - Vocational Rehabilitation
 - McKinney Act (for youth who are homeless/transient)
 - Child Welfare Protections (Right to Permanency Planning)

Education Rights

- Eligibility for Educational Services: IEPs and Placement (IDEA/Section 504)
- Discipline
- Least Restrictive Environment
 - Note: State laws/constitutions that may be more protective than the federal law

 - Manifestation Determination Review (MDR)
 - Review/Revision of FBA and BIP (What FBA and BIP?)
 - Stay Put
 - Stay Put Exceptions
 - Services While Out

Informal Removal/Changes of Placement

False Dichotomy

- "Sent Homes"
- Homebound/Tutoring
- Virtual
- Shortened Day
- Risk/Threat Assessment ("Out Until")
- Insert Other Sneaky Technique Here...

School Discipline Hearings: FASD Factors

- Medication Failure
- Communication Skills
- Demonstrations of "Remorse"
- Demonstrations of "Respect"
- Confessions and Juvenile Justice Implications
- Impulse Control ("candy closet")

Substituted Decision Making

- Overuse/Overly Broad Use of Guardianship/Conservatorship
 - Limit Absolutely As Possible
 - Use Natural Supports

- Representing When There Is A Lack of Parental Involvement
 - G.A.L./Emancipation/ "Next Friend"
 - Surrogate Parent (IDEA)

Child Welfare

- State Overuse of Institutional Care
 - Outcomes...
 - Lack of Treatment and Oversight
 - Community Based Alternatives
 - Medicaid Funded Therapy In the Community
 - Case Oversight
 - Therapeutic Foster Care
 - Support for Foster Care/ Kinship Care
